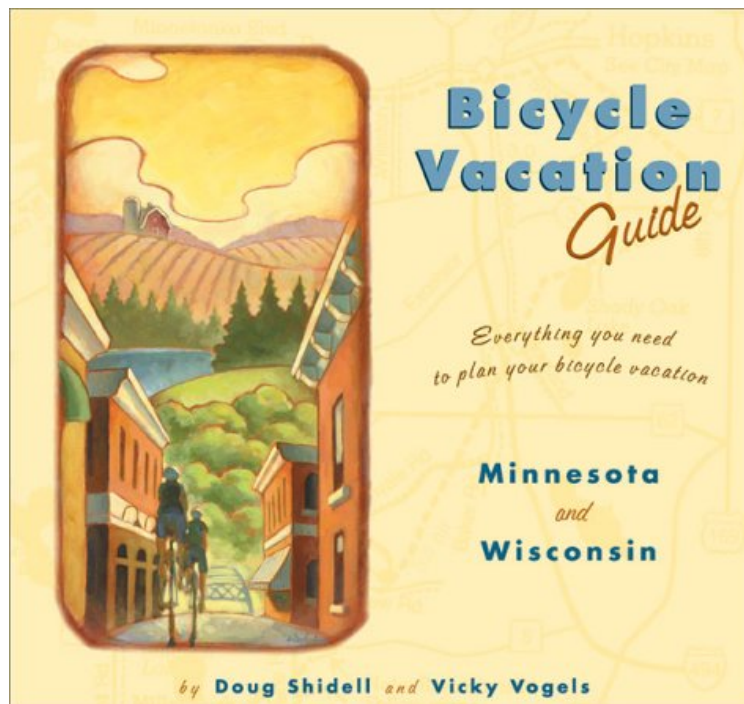

There's a lot of information in here (the book was expanded by 60 pages), so we spent some time arranging it in the most readable format possible. The color maps have also been tweaked and cleaned up. Overall, Bicycle Vacation Guide is packed with information and, if we must say so ourselves, quite a sharp looking book.

From the AuthorWe researched a number of new trails, but added only the most interesting. The Mesabi Trail in Minnesota's Iron Range is fascinating because it defies most of the standard rules about rail trails. It dips and rolls and winds through back streets of small towns, and it stays close to the mining history of this part of Minnesota. The Lake Wobegon Trail is named after the fictional town in Garrison Keillor's *Prairie Home Companion*, and the characters and lifestyle are all there big as life. We had a lot of fun updating and adding to Bicycle Vacation Guide.
