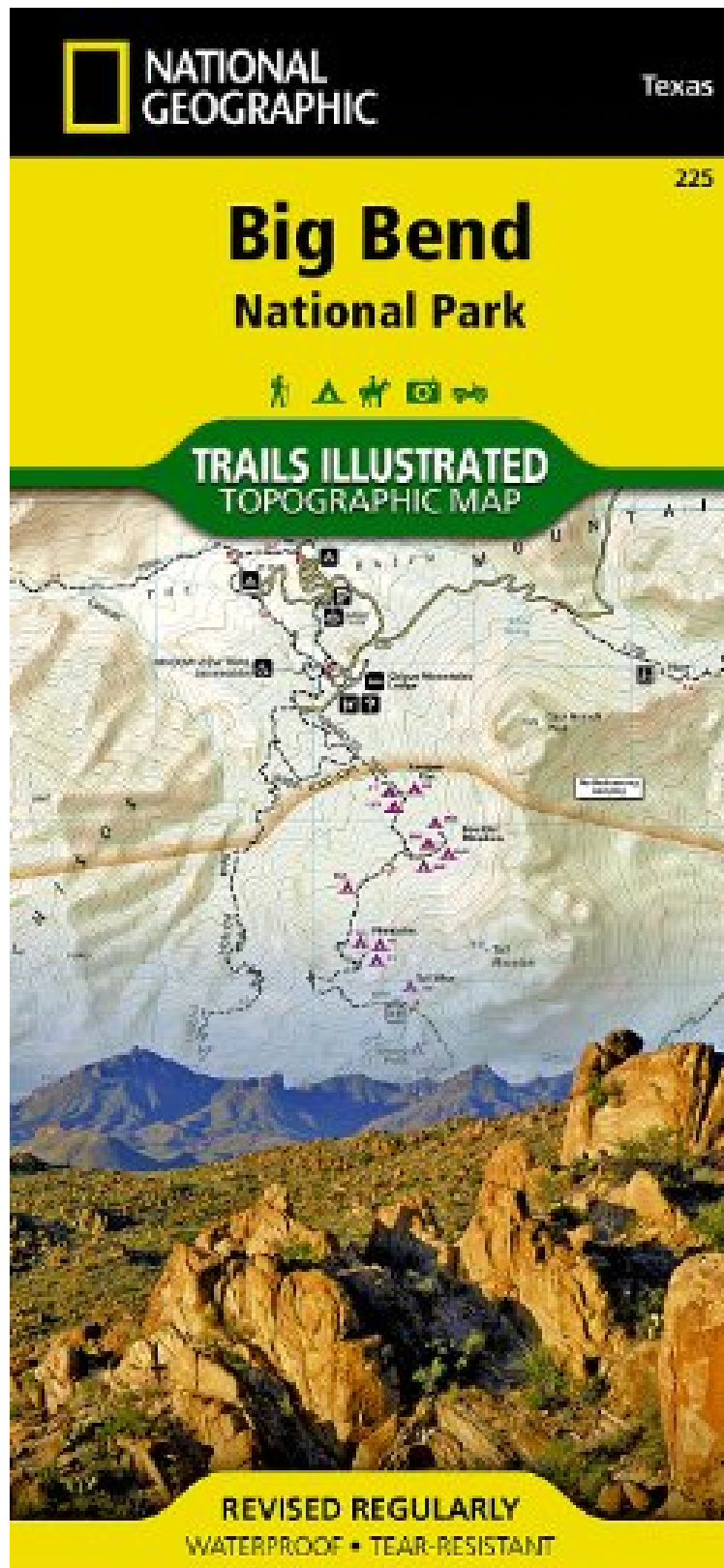

The quality of the map is great and was very useful as my friend and I went backpacked the outer mountain loop + south rim trail (4 days total). Big Bend is one of the largest national parks, and this map covers it all and does a good job. One side is the whole park, and the other is a larger scale map of the Chisos. I carried this map with me while hiking the Marufo Vega trail (but I recommend getting a 7.5-minute map or having a good GPS for that hike) and while hiking in the Chisos.
