The restaurant information seems lacking in detail and the rides/attractions seem incomplete (nothing, for instance, about the mini-attractions in Flick's Fun Fair for little kids). Maybe this is more of an issue of incomplete/inadequate editorial review, but I am not as satisfied as I usually am with Birnbaum's quality as the "official" guide of Disney Parks. Still, the colorful pages, pictures, maps, are helpful

In the end, this guide just doesn't have much substance. It is a fine introduction to the park if you haven't been there, but for the real skinny on Disneyland, I like the "Unofficial Guide" series much better.
