The book includes some fascinating details about the geology and history of the islands, and the photos are terrific. That said, this is not the best for planning a visit, or taking along on one. At 11x8, it sized for the coffee table. At 63 pages, there isn't enough here to serve as a memento. The information on getting to/among the islands is limited, scattered, and out-of-date. The list of organizations, mentioned in the table of contents, is missing. This book feels like something one might buy on impulse at the gift shop, on the way back. We may pick up a copy in the future, but don't consider it essential.Potential visitors would be MUCH better served by Christopher Klein's Discovering the Boston Harbor Islands, which has far more detail, is better organized, and is more suitably-sized for pack or coat pocket.6 of 6 people found the following review helpful.
