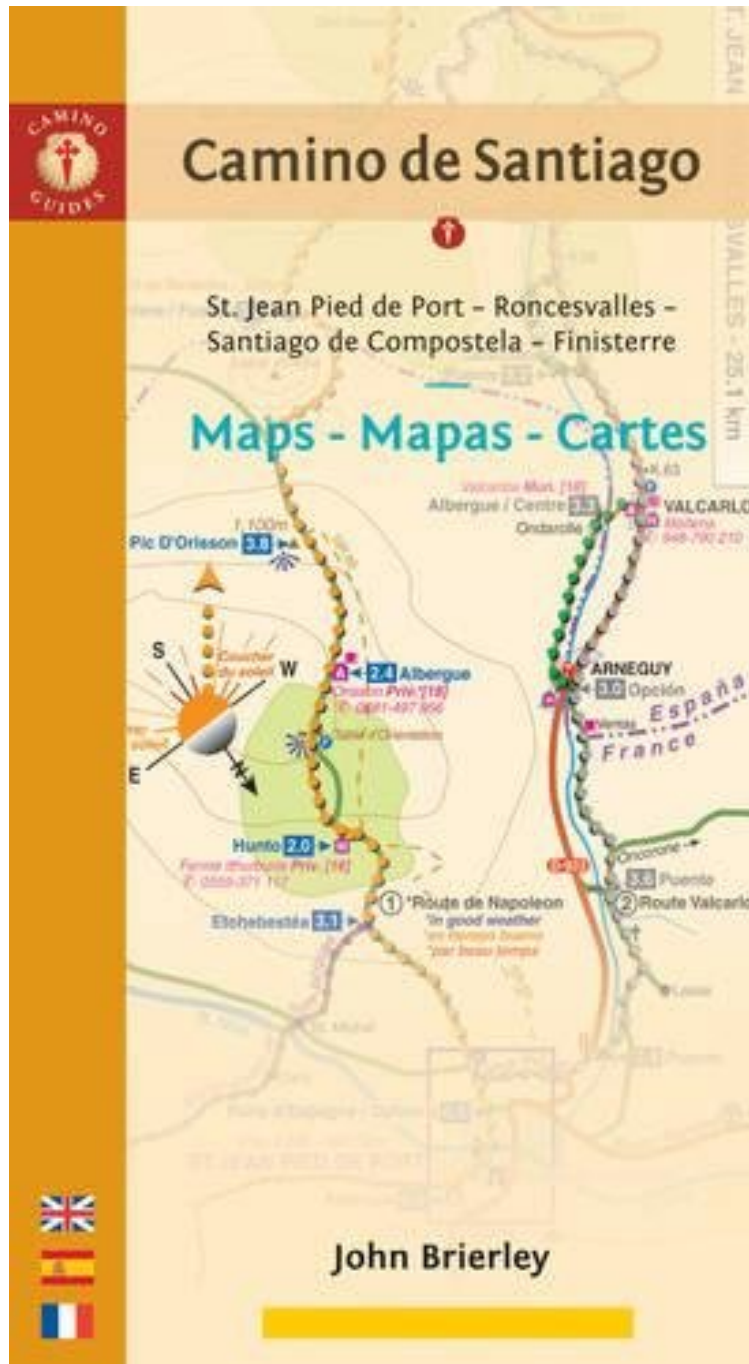

This is the pocket edition that is meant to be light weight for carrying on the trail, though the extra languages take up space/weight. It actually has the route to Muxia and Finisterris also if you are planning on walking to the 'end of the world'It has the same maps as in his 'A Pilgrim's Guide'. I'll be very tempted to carry the heavier book, because of the historical information contained in it.
