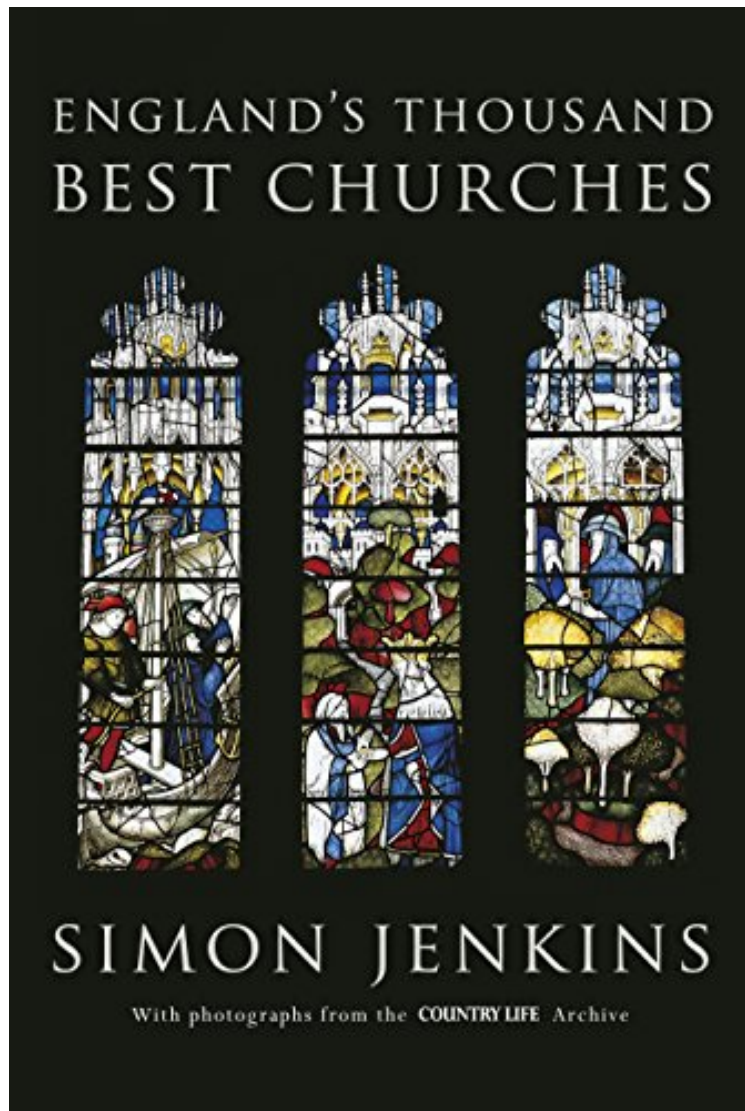

Simon Jenkins has travelled the length and breadth of England to select his thousand best churches. Jenkins contends that these churches house a gallery of vernacular art without equal in the world. Here, he brings that museum to public attention.
