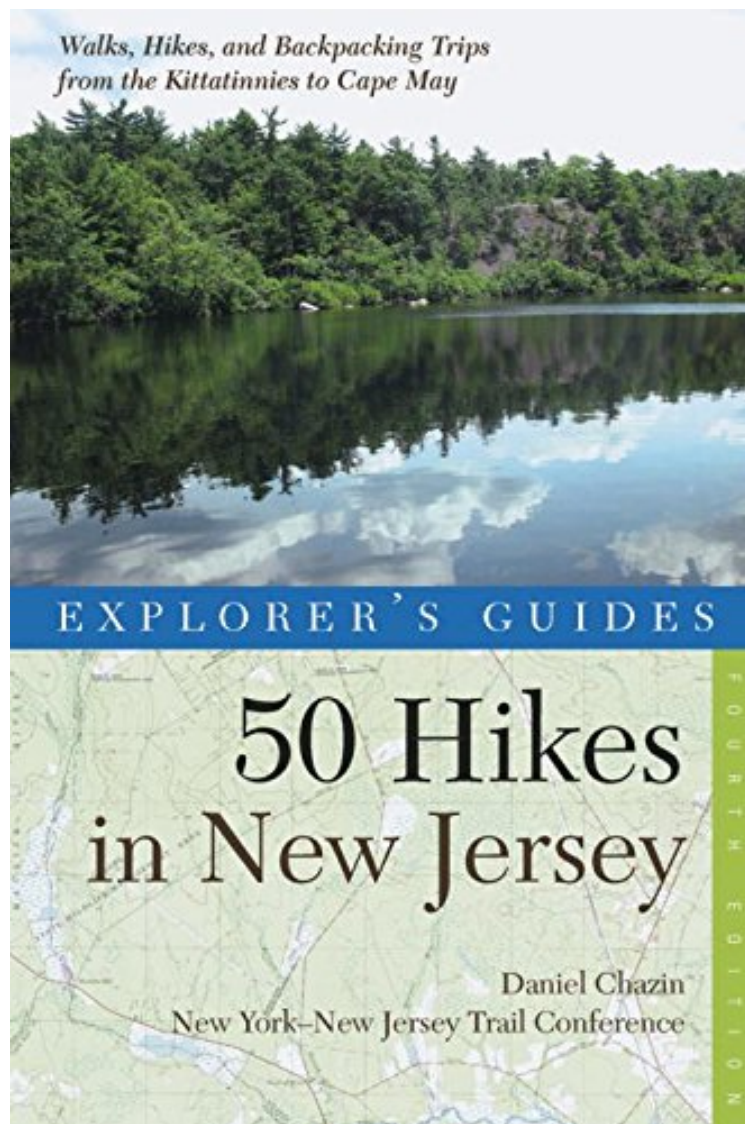

This is an excellent guidebook. The hikes are scattered throughout NJ, though a majority are in the Northern part of the state. The back of the book shows where they are in NJ (there is also a map inside). There is a guide at the start, which lists the distance, elevation, level of difficulty and gives binary answers on whether the hike has good views, waterfalls, camping or is good for kids. Each hike has photos in it on the highlights. It has directions on how to get there, particularly off the highways and where to park. Each entry has a history of the area, includes a map (not pull-outs) of the hike, guide to the hike for important sites and every major turn, and an elevation chart (which clearly shows where to expect large inclines and declines). It's wonderful. I've done many of the hikes and have found this to be an outstanding book. Great for beginners and experts alike. If you like this, you might want to consider buying the 50 hikes in the Lower Hudson Valley in NY. Same NJ-NY Trail Conference and expert author.
