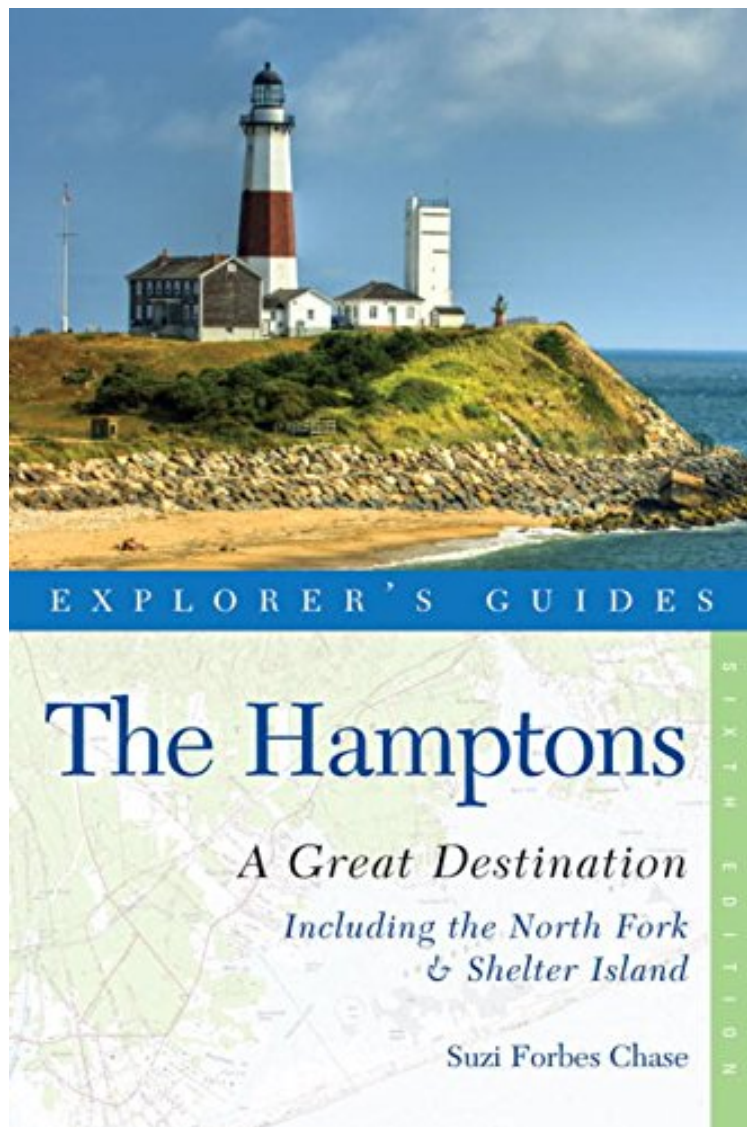

There is some useful information on the history of the area but at the end of the day I wish I had not bought it as it was pretty useless and also bulky to travel with. The layout of the book is confusing and there is a lack of focus and also a lack of real perception of the area from the point of view of the tourist. However there is a surprising general lack of tourist information available, the local 'tourist maps' available free are pretty useless and there is little to help the visitor, for example, absolutely no road signs (except the one as you leave East Hampton which reads 'New York 90 miles'), therefore the book can be useful in order to gain an overview of what is there, but with far far too much information on eating, sleeping and shopping and little advice on how to get around.1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
