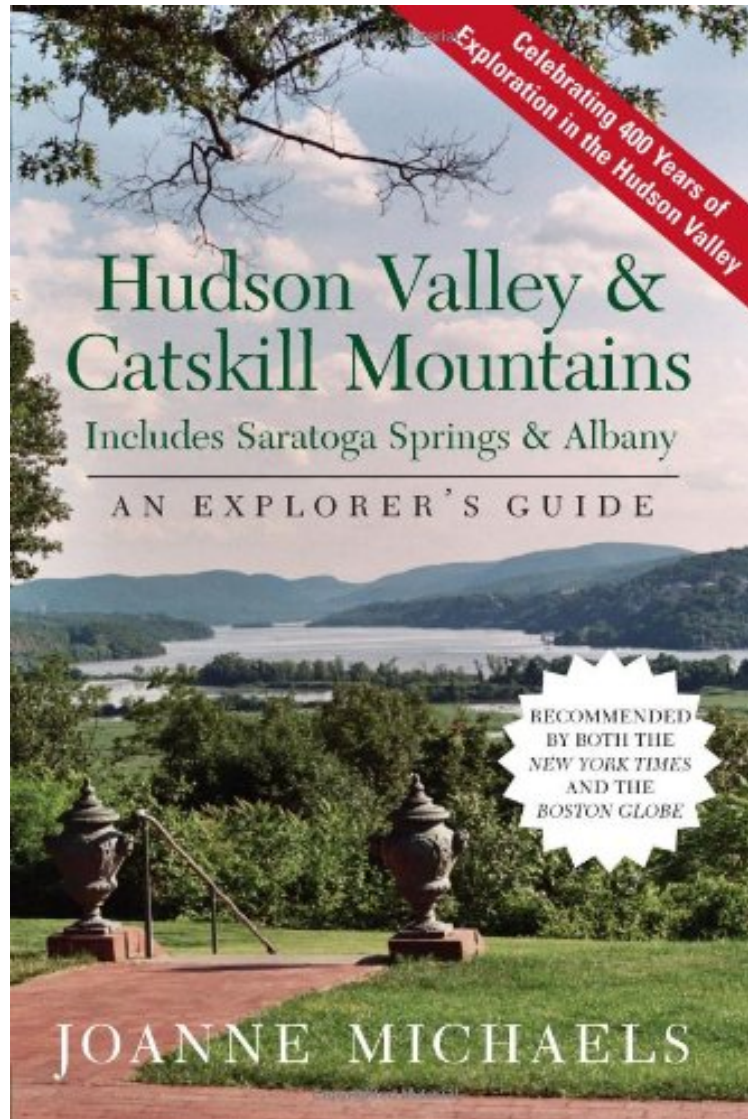

So if you were looking at a town in one county wanted to see how far it was from the town you were in in another county - even near the county line - you're out of luck. It might have been a good idea for a map of a county to show 15 miles of detail into the surrounding counties - shaded a different color of course.
