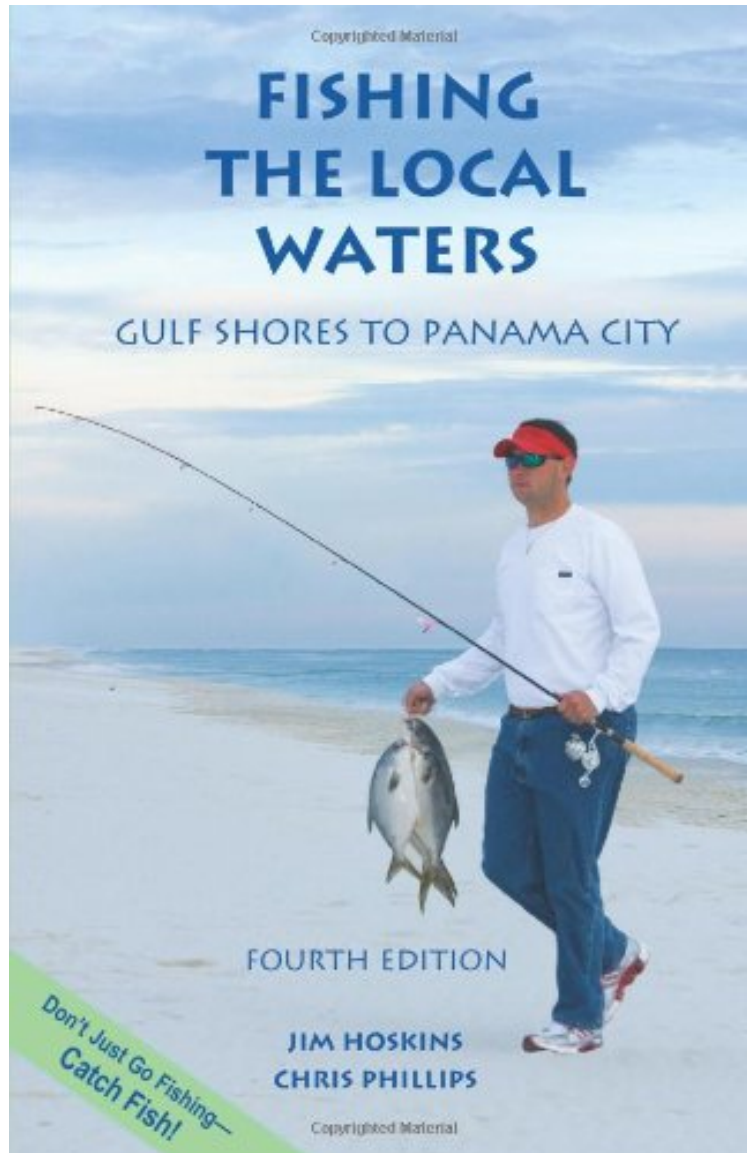

book is about as fundamental as it gets. The diagrams/maps/etc look like they were drawn by a child, the black and white photographs have little contrast and/or useful detail.
