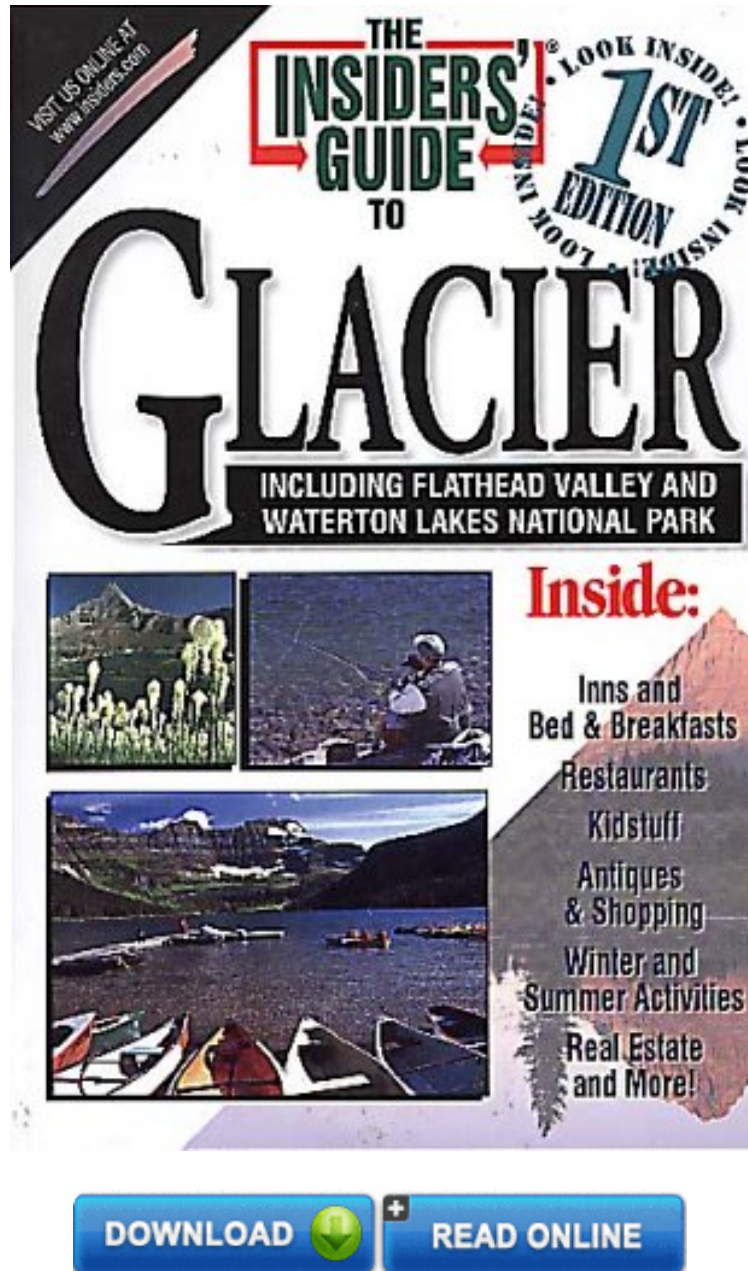

Returned Book By Ethan I returned this book after 20 minutes of reading it. 1) It is too dense...they try to cover too much territory and for a dummies guide for somebody who has never been there before - they don't organize the information too well. I had trouble figuring out what I should read and what I shouldn't. 2) It really doesn't provide opinions on anything - most of the verbiage here is stock and doesn't provide any true insight into a hike, hotel or activity that is a can't miss or totally skippable. 3) It is really boring...I needed to return the book for another one to get excited about the trip. Mainly, it is just really hard to find information that is relevant. As a case in point, one of the areas of the park is famously both in Canada and the US. I was curious if you need a passport, need to go through customs, etc. After the fifth long paragraph, I gave up. The other guide I purchased had the information easier to find and apparent and yes - you do need to go through customs and the whole nine even if you are in the middle of a hike. And, you need to purchase the Canadian version of the park pass. All fundamental things not found in this book.
