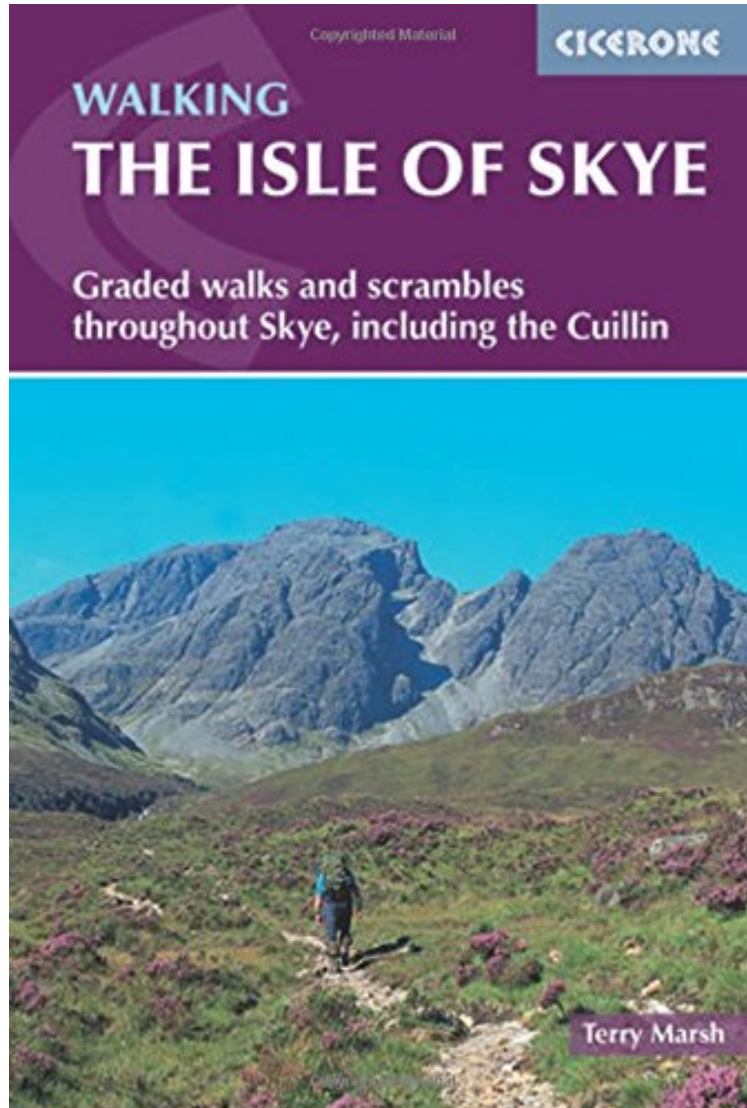

This guidebook describes 87 walks and scrambles on the Isle of Skye, visiting the island's most awe-inspiring scenery including Sleat and South-East Skye, Strath, Minginish, Duirinish, Waternish, Trotternish and the Cuillin. The routes explore many different landscapes on the island, ranging from coastal walks, lonely lochans, coastal cliffs and forests to Munros and mountain traverses, with exposure for experienced scramblers. There are hard, demanding days as tough as anything in the British Isles and the walks are in wonderfully isolated situations. The guide includes notes on history and geology as well as all useful local information. The Isle of Skye is a place of elemental forces, a land that man has barely scratched.
