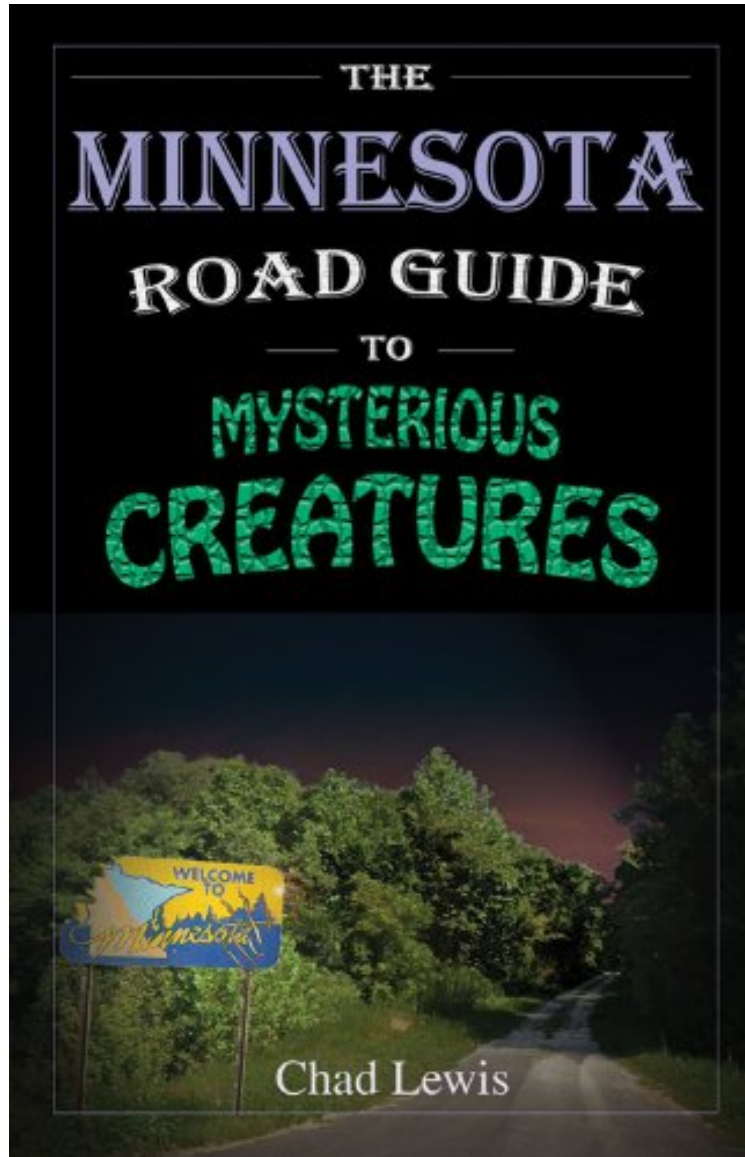

I do so, because I just finished his most recent book and enjoyed it so much so that I felt the greatest desire to put the proverbial pen to paper. The author Chad Lewis skillfully compiled a wide range of unexplained, mysterious, and possibly paranormal legends and lore. The reader can easily approach the work two ways. Whether from a cover to back jacket straight read through or as a stand-alone resource material, both will be equally enjoyed. I myself hopped around reading an entry or two with breakfast over a week choosing the legend on my mood at that moment. I most thoroughly enjoyed "Case 6" detailing a UFO/Alien/Winged Sprite 'things' attacking the cross-country truck driver. Lewis's documentation of following up with the police, the truck stop employees and newspaper reporters motivated me.
