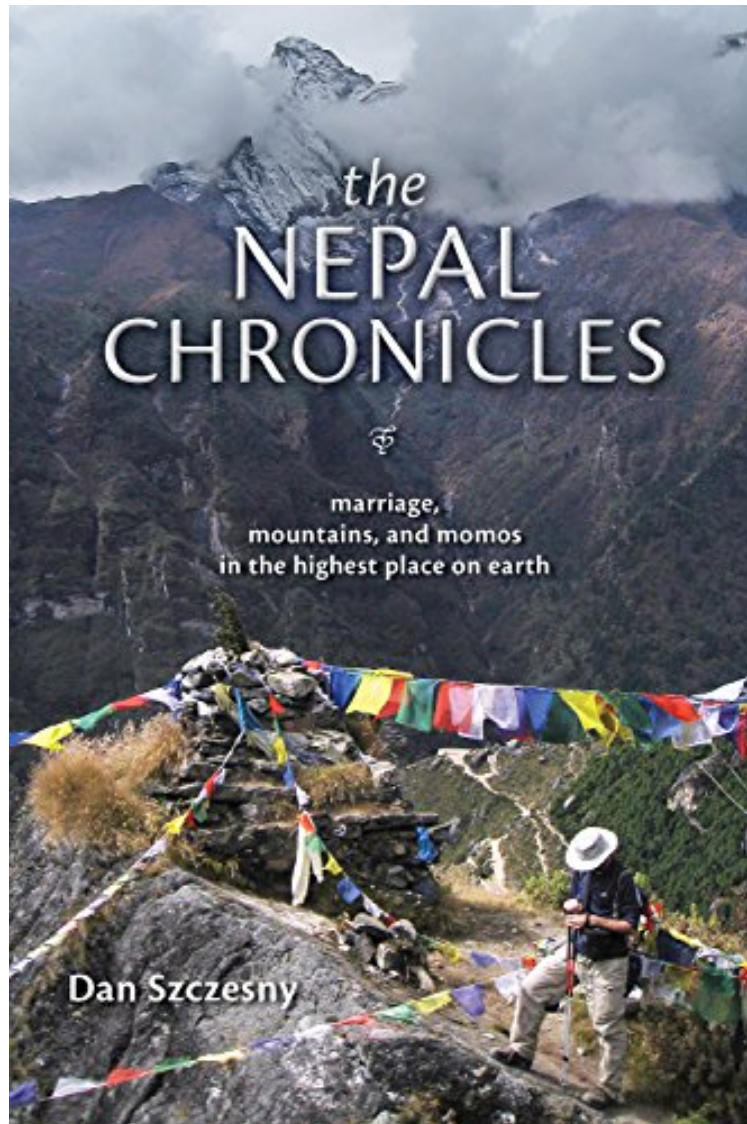

His first book, *The Adventures of Buffalo and Tough Cookie*, is a hiking memoir about a one year, 225-mile journey through some of New Hampshire's least known wilderness with his 10-year-old foster daughter. Dan began his career in Buffalo, New York. Since then, he has written for a wide variety of regional and national publications, including the *Main Line Times*, *Philadelphia Weekly*, *Christian Science Monitor*, *Princeton Packet*, *Eastern Mountain Sports*, *The Good Men Project*, and *Pennsylvania Magazine*. In 2000, he moved to New Hampshire to cover the Presidential Election for the Associated Press. In 2001, Dan became Associate Publisher of *The Hippo*, now the state's largest weekly Arts and Entertainment journal. He's a member of the Appalachian Mountain Club's 4,000-footer club and has written extensively about the outdoors and hiking. He has camped in the Grand Canyon and thru-hiked England's Coast to Coast Trail. He lives in Manchester, NH, with his wife Meenakshi.
