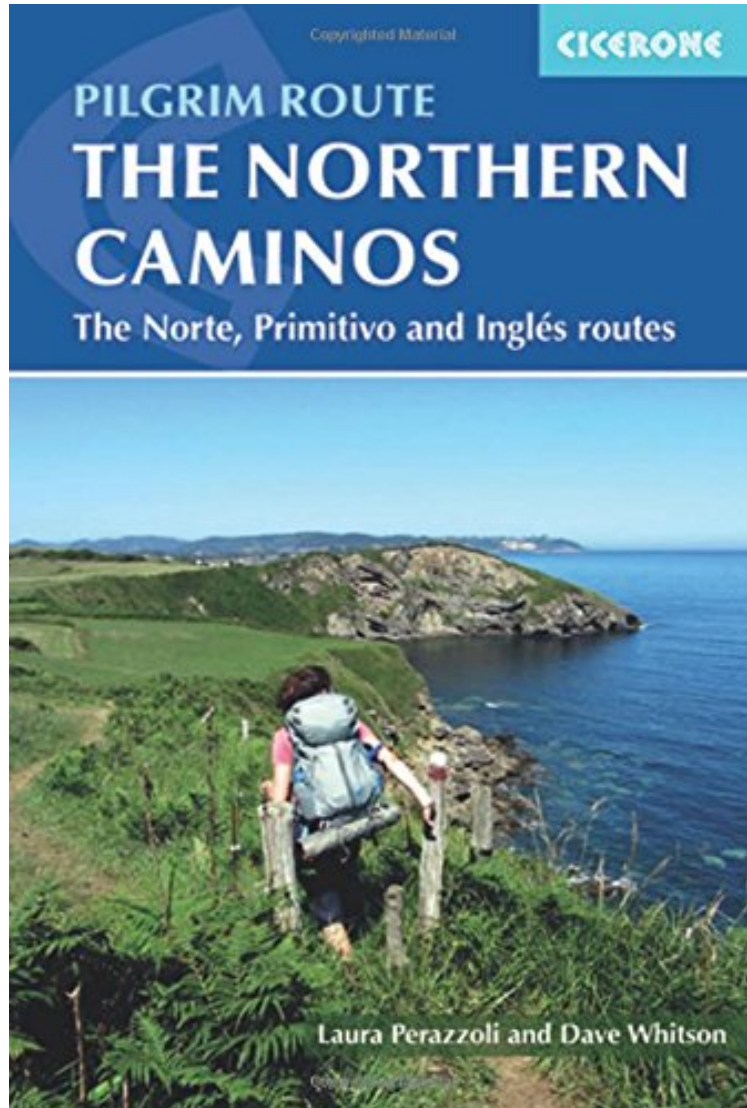

About the Author Dave Whitson has walked extensively on pilgrim roads in Europe. A teacher in Portland, Oregon, he has led seven student group pilgrimages, including four on the Franc's and one on the Norte. He has walked the Norte and Primitivo three times. Laura Perazzoli was a student on one of Dave's first group pilgrimages, on the Franc's. She has since led her own groups on the Franc's and Norte. She walked the Norte and Primitivo in 2009 and 2011, and the Ingl's in 2011.
