Spickler You got to be a little weird to want a book on the outdoor sculptures in Washington D.C. In my case I have a great grandfather who was an architect and one of his lesser known works is a statue based memorial sponsored by the Grand Army of the Republic. The book is, as far as I can tell, quite complete and offered interesting information on my great grandfathers work. The photographs are all in black and white and the works organized by street. The index offers names of the artists making the sculpture as well as the name of the monument although architects are only mentioned on the page of the memorial. There are a number of useful maps. Anyone who is following historical monuments or the art of sculpturing should be pleased with the book.
