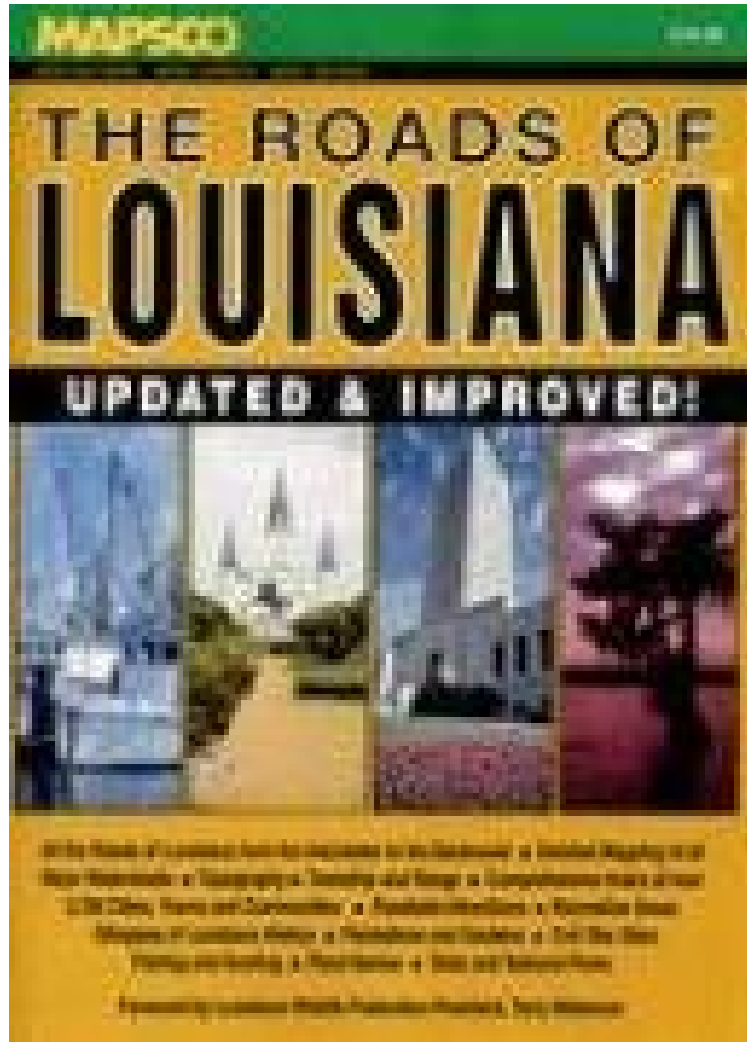

Fortunately, I kept the old one, tattered though it is. This one looks good, but the names of roads and streams are often impossible to read (yeah my eyes are older, but I have no problem reading the type in the earlier edition). And this one is full of egregious errors. For example, Cameron Prairie NWR is pictured far north of its actual location--on private land. It doesn't even overlap with the actual location. Look at the corporate limits of Hackberry. What, did they annex a large chunk of Sabine NWR? Whoever was responsible for this atlas should be fired. I hope they fix the problems for the next edition. The old

The muted, grayish-green background colors make the print difficult to read---not enough contrast.. The previous edition was much clearer, printing details over pale yellow backgrounds.
