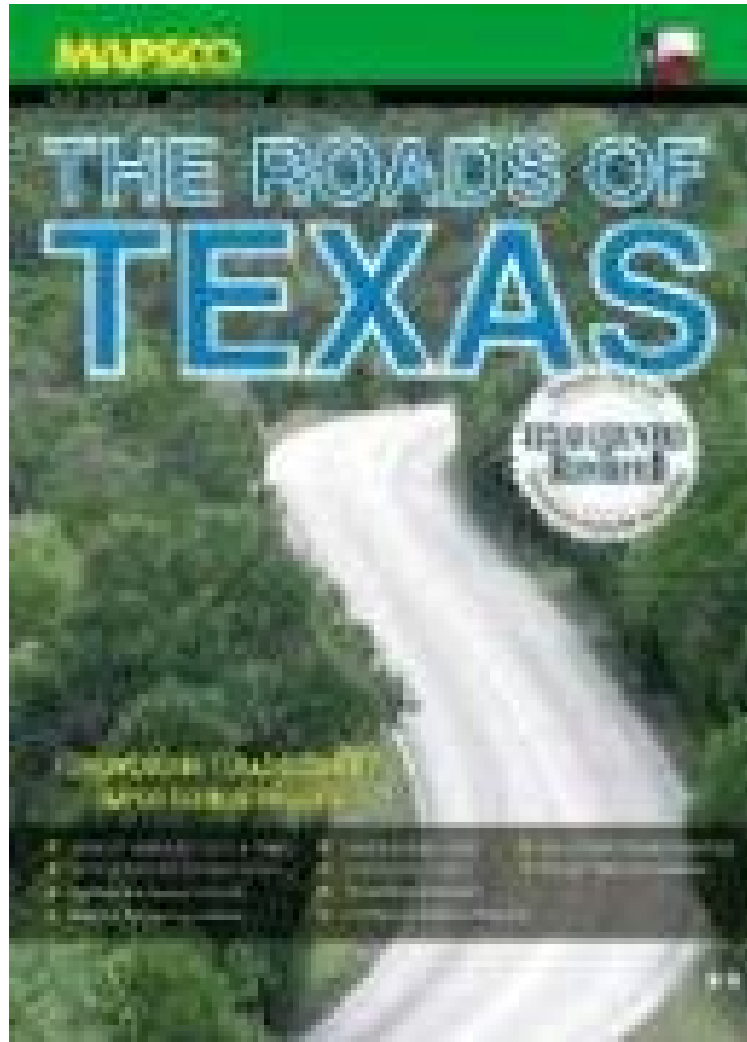

However....I discovered that numerous county roads in the county where I live are not up to date. For whatever reason, many of them were renumbered from the 100s to the 200s (i.e., Co. Rd. 145 is now Co. Rd. 268), probably 5 or more years ago. This was confusing to many people (including us) when we first moved to our new location almost 2 years ago. I would think the Texas Dept. of Transportation (TXDOT) would have all the current information. Also, many of the online map services still don't have our correct road number address so that people who use them can't easily locate us! Not sure where they get their information.Hopefully the newest updated version of The

Roads of Texas (with 15,000 corrections...according to MAPSCO) will have made all of the necessary changes. Hopefully.)4 of 4 people found the following review helpful.
